Part 1: Complete the algorithm below:

```

BEGIN
INPUT N
Assign N to A
FOR i from 1 TO 7
    Assign _____ to A
    DISPLAY A
END FOR
END
    
```

Part 2: Press the **PRGM** key and create a NEW program called "SQRT".

EDIT the program on your calculator by selecting the appropriate instructions of the CTL and E/S (or I/O) menus.

Part 3: Run the program: Find approximations to 10^{-7} of the square roots of 2, 3, 5, 7, 10.
